The School of Natural, Health, Social and Behavioral Sciences at Centenary University offers programs to provide you with a strong foundation in liberal arts and life sciences. Our Bachelor of Science degrees ensure that you receive the vital knowledge to flourish and enhance the well-being of society.

Biology

Biology concentrates on the major characteristics of life through the study of biology, chemistry, physics, anatomy, physiology, ecology, microbiology and genetics. Our program provides a foundation for students pursuing additional degrees in medicine, dentistry, physician assistant, chiropractic, and biological graduate programs. With our Bachelor of Science in Biology, you also have the option of choosing from three concentrations: Environmental Science, Forensic Science, or Pre-Healthcare.

Exercise Science

This program provides in-depth knowledge of biology, human anatomy, physiology, exercise, and human performance. This program prepares you for certifications in health and wellness or for graduate programs in athletic training, physical therapy or occupational therapy.

Forensic Science

Enjoy a strong mix of foundational biology and chemistry courses with specialized courses in the field of criminal justice and forensics. This program ensures that students have real-world training with actual evidence collection specialists. This program prepares you for a career in forensics or in pharmaceutical and biotechnology companies.

Health Science

Courses include human biology, health sciences, psychology, sociology, health care policy, and public health. An internship in a healthcare field is required for graduation and increases your experiential learning. This degree prepares you for a nonclinical position in healthcare or with the foundational coursework to pursue graduate programs in physical and occupational therapy.

Medical Laboratory Science (MLS)

This NAACLS-accredited program allows graduates to take the ASCP Board of Registry exam and work in hospital and public health laboratories. Includes 2.5 years of foundational scientific discovery and 1.5 years of laboratory techniques and disease diagnosis. Students spend the last semester (16 weeks) in a hospital laboratory training with a certified medical laboratory scientist.

Public Health

The Public Health program includes human biology, health and wellness, social and behavioral sciences, epidemiology, public policy, and health sciences. You can build on a common public health knowledge and then concentrate in a specific area of your particular interest, e.g., global health or community psychology.
